Aims and Objectives

To encourage members and their families to excel in their respective spheres of activities and professions. Host an annual awards ceremony recognizing exceptional achievements in various fields such as business, education, arts, sports, and community service. Categories can include "Business Excellence," "Academic Achievement," "Cultural Contribution," and more.

Celebrate cultural festivals relevant to the Agarwal traditions, such as Teej, Deepawali, Sankranti, Holi, and other significant cultural occasions. Include traditional music, dance, art exhibitions, and food stalls to showcase Agarwal heritage.

Maintaining details of all the members and their families in the form of HYCAP Directory for establishing contacts at special occasions like marriages, childbirth, medical or any other emergency.

Moral and material support to the member families at the time of special occasions like marriages, childbirth, medical or any other emergency.

Organization of excursion tours to the places of community interest and arrangement of informative guest lectures.

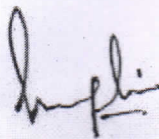
Assistance to new entrants to Hyderabad through help in accommodation and other miscellaneous areas.

The Association is formed with no profit motive and commercial activities is involved in its working

Membership Rules

Membership is open to Agarwal Professionals in Hyderabad. Agarwal is one of whose Gotra is any of the 18 Agarwal Gotras.

Professionals means those persons who are qualified and or experienced in any profession such as Engineers, Doctors, Architects, CAs, Lawyers, MBAs, IIMs, IAS, IPS and Allied Services, Defense Commissioned Services or any other person who has achieved outstanding status in his profession.



These persons may be working in Government or Semi-Government or Private or Self- Employed or Retired.

A nominal one-time new membership fee of Rs.2500.00 is to be charged for becoming new member to the association. This can be changed through recommendation of Managing Committee (MC) to the General Body (GB) and duly approved in AGM/EGM.

The membership can be by members or their spouses. The membership is for members their spouses and minor children below 10 years.

Admission of Members

There shall be a membership committee constituted as follows: Convener Membership Committee - to be elected / selected by Managing Committee, President and Secretary

Any person seeking membership to HYCAP will submit his application complete in all respect along with documents on the prescribed Performa, to the Convener Membership Committee. This can be done on line also using scanned copies of the documents.

The application will be proposed by one existing member (of one year standing) and seconded by another existing member (of one year standing).

The convener will discuss all applications in the membership committee. The membership committee based on the Gotra, education, financial and social status of the person under consideration will recommend for consideration to the MC.

The MC before final decision will invite the applicant and his spouse at least in one of the Social meeting for fellowship to give them a feeling of the HYCAP atmosphere the applicant will be requested to introduce him and the family in the meeting.

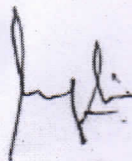
The concerned person will get duly inducted into HYCAP by paying the requisite sums as new Membership free and annual membership.

There is no place for inactive members in HYCAP. If a member or MC member misses 3 consecutive functions / meetings, his membership will be liable for termination. The membership committee will automatically consider this matter and if felt necessary recommend to the MC for his termination of membership.

If the activities of any of the members are found to be detrimental to the interests of the association, the 2/3rd majority of the MC and to be ratified by General Body can terminate his membership.

Annual Subscription

Annual subscription would be Rs. 10,000.00. (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) This can be changed through recommendation of MC to the GB and duly approved in AGM/EGM. Member joining for less than half part of the year will be charged 50 % of the annual subscription amount for the year of entry.



The members should pay the subscription of the year on or before 31st August of the year. A one time, late payment fee of Rs. 100/- will be charged after 31st August, till 30th September failing which it will be assumed that the member concerned is not interested in HYCAP. The subject would be brought to the attention of the MC and suitable action to that effect to be taken and shared with the concerned member.

Rights of Members

- To attend and take part in the General Body meeting of the associations
- To move resolution at the General Body Meeting
- To bring to the notice of the Managing Committee their concerns and suggestions.
- To inspect the records of the association with prior notice and writing of Ten Days to the secretary.

Function of the General Body

- To adopt the report presented by the secretary about the performance of the association.
- To adopt the audited accounts submitted by the Treasurer.
- To approve the plan of action for the current year.
- To approve the budget for the current year.
- To appoint the auditors as and when due.

Managing Committee

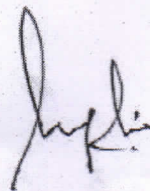
The association shall be managed by an Managing Committee (MC) consisting of the following:

1. President	One
2. Vice President	One
3. Secretary	One
4. Joint Secretary	One
5. Treasurer	One
6. Members (Two members to be ladies)	Five
7. Immediate Past President	One

Total numbers of Managing Committee member's eleven

The term of the Executive Committee shall be for a period of one year i.e. from 1st July to 30th June of the next year. The new body will therefore be elected latest by June 15th every year and take over charge from 1st July of the same year.

The MC will meet at least once in a month either in person or online and maintain the minutes in Minutes Register.



Elections to the Managing Committee

The new President shall be elected by the existing MC as follows.

The Vice President will automatically take over as President. If he declines, the secretary will be asked to take over as President. If he also declines, the existing MC will elect / select one person (having at least two years' experience on the MC) out of the existing MC members for the post of President.

If the process as above does not result in selecting a president, then the same will be reported to GB for necessary action.

The new Secretary will be elected / selected by the existing MC members from amongst the MC members keeping in mind the following points:

He should be able to go well with the President He should be active and promoter of HYCAP aims. He should be resourceful (typing, computer, clerical office resources etc.) He should be having preferably two years' experience.

The finalization of the new President and Secretary should preferably be completed before the AGM every year.

The General Body will elect the remaining members (at least two ladies) as members to the MC. The HYCAP members should ensure that only active persons who are interested in promoting the aims and objectives of HYCAP are elected to the MC.

Any member seeking election to the MC should be having at least one year's standing in HYCAP and should have attended minimum 3 functions during the year can only contest and fill his nomination form for the MC.

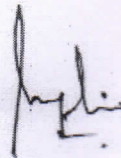
If the adequate No. of applications seeking election to the MC is not received by the due date as specified by the returning officer, then the balance names can be identified and finalized by the General Body.

Election of MC members should be completed by 1st July every year.

Newly elected committee will then elect / select the Vice President, Joint Secretary and Treasurer from amongst the elected members. The Vice President should be preferably having one-year experience on the MC. The Treasurer should preferably have some financial management experience.

All MC members have equal rights. In case of a tie, the President will put his casting vote:

All members of the outgoing MC are eligible for re-election through the General Body except that those who have served on the MC for 4 years have to give a break of at least one year before seeking re-election.



Function of Managing Committee

The MC will organize get-togethers of all the member families, as frequently as possible, say about once in 3 months and promote fellowship.

The MC shall maintain accounts of all receipts and expenditures and annual accounts to be placed before the GB and duly approved during AGM. The quorum required for the General Body Meeting will be one third of the membership. All decisions can be based on Simple Majority. In case there is no quorum, the meeting can be adjourned. New meeting can be rescheduled after 10 minutes without any need to give advance notice and no quorum will be necessary for the rescheduled meeting.

All assets of HYCAP such as banners, public address system etc. will be managed by team of Vice President and Joint Secretary. An asset register will be maintained. These will be handed over to the new MC at the completion of the term of the committee.

MC can form subcommittees for any activity or any function by co-opting members from the General Body.

The allocation of responsibilities for various activities to the members of MC can be done within the committee. Mandatory activities to be undertaken are selection of new members undertaking social get together, any other special events or programs like sports day, music day, publishing HYCAP Highlights, HYCAP directory, Rolling Trophy etc.

In case it is approved by the MC, the association can seek affiliation with the state / national associations of the community.

President

He/She will preside over the General Body Meeting and Managing Committee Meetings. The President will represent the Association at any Government or Statutory authority and private bodies. The president will have a casting vote on matters decided on majority votes.

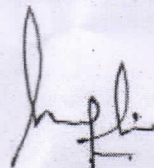
Vice President

He/She shall assist the President in discharging his/her duties. The Vice President shall officiate as President in the absence of the President. He/She will also perform any other duties to him/her.

General secretary

He/She is the Chief Executive officer of the Association and custodian of all records relating to the Association and corresponds on behalf of the Association. He has to record all minutes and all meetings. Convenes various meetings with the permission of the President. He will guide the treasurer on preparing the budget and expenditure statement to be placed before the General Body. Other duties of the General Secretary are:

- a. Convene the Managing Committee Meetings at regular intervals/emergency meetings when required.
- b. Receive complaints/Suggestions from all the members appropriate action.
- c. Associate with president and accompany him/her to make any representation to any Government/Local body on matters of interest to the Society.



- d. Convene the Annual General Body Meeting with at least 21 days notice to all members.
- e. Call Emergency Committee Meetings or Extra General Body Meetings if and when required.
- f. Get the accounts of the Association audited every year with the Treasurer.
- g. Keep proper records of the resolutions passed by the managing Committee and General Body and submit the necessary statutory returns and other correspondence.
- h. Correspond and initiate legal proceedings on behalf of the Association to protect the Interest of the Society.

Joint Secretary:

The Joint Secretary has to do the work entrusted by the Managing Committee from time to time. He/She should keep himself/herself abreast with the day to day affairs of the Committee and perform the duties of the General secretary in his/her absence.

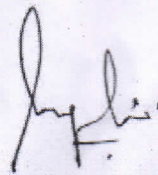
Treasurer:

The Treasurer is responsible for proper maintenance of accounts, fund collection and expenditure as authorized by the Managing Committee. All expenditure to be supported by bills, invoices, vouchers etc. Should be one of signatories in the bank accounts operation. Other duties are:

1. Arrange collection of Annual subscriptions from members and deposit the same in the Bank.
2. Present Yearly statement of accounts with receipts expenditure.
3. Bring to the notice of the Managing Committee about any defaulters once in three months and pursue the collection with the joint Secretary.
4. Render annual accounts to the auditor to get the accounts audited and present the audited reports to the Managing Committee and then to the General Body for ratification.
5. Issue regular receipts for the collections made from the members.
6. Clarify any observations on the accounts raised by the members.

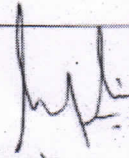

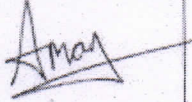
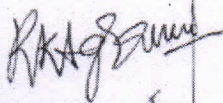
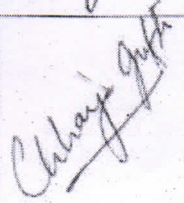
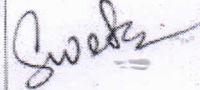
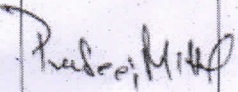

- A. General Body of the Members of the Association will be convened by the Managing Committee at least once in a year by giving minimum 21 days notice.
- B. The General Body may amend or alter bye-laws/constitution by 2/3rd majority voting by the members present. Any such alteration should be communicated to the Registrar of Societies in writing by the General Secretary.
- C. Members of the General Body may choose to amalgamate any other society into it or merge into any other society with Similar Objectives or dissolve the Association by 2/3 majority of the members present convened General Body Meeting.
- D. The quorum for the Managing Committee meetings shall be five. The quorum for the General Body Meeting shall be one third of the members on the Registered members. No quorum is required for the adjourned meetings of the General Body.
- E. The terms of the Managing Committee shall be for a period of One year extendable up to Two years and it shall continue till a new body is elected after two years tenure. Election to the Managing Committee shall be conducted in democratic manner by a Returning Officer nominated by the Managing Committee.



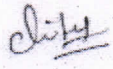
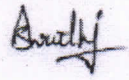

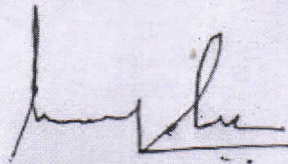
FUNCTIONS

FUNCTIONS OF THE EXECUTIVE BODY AND OFFICE BEARERS


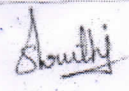
1. **PRESIDENT:** - He Presides over all the meeting of the both General Body and Executive Committee, he can cast his vote in case of tie. He can supervise all the branches of the society.
2. **Vice PRESIDENT:** - He shall assist the president in discharging his duties in the absence of the President he shall perform the duty of the President as entrusted by him.
3. **SECRETARY:** - He is their Executive Officer of the society and custodian to all records relating to the society and correspondent on behalf of the society. He has to take on records of all minutes of the society to convey both the bodies of the society with the permission of the President. He guide the treasurer in preparing the budget and expenditure statement of the Society.
4. **JOINT SECRETARY:** - He has to do the work entrusted by the executive committee. He has to assist the Secretary in discharging his duties, in the absence of the secretary, he can perform the duties of the Secretary.
5. **TREASURER:** - He is responsible for all-financial transactions and funds of the society. He has to maintain accounts properly along with the vouchers he has to prepare the accounts of the society jointly with the Secretary or President.
6. **OFFICE BEARERS:** - They are the responsible person to attend to such activities of the Society Which the Executive Committee entrust to them.
7. **QUORUM:** - One Third of the total members for General Body Meeting and $\frac{1}{4}$ for Executive Committee Meeting.
8. **Funds:** - The funds shall be spent only for the attachment of the objects of the society and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly to any of the members through any means
9. **Amendments:** - No amendment or alteration shall be made in the purpose of the association unless it is voted by $\frac{2}{3}$ of its members present at a special meeting conveyed for the purpose and confirmed by $\frac{2}{3}$ of the members present at a second special meeting.
10. **Winding up:** - in case the society has to be wound up the property and funds of the society that remain after discharging the liabilities, if any, shall be transferred or paid to some other institutions with similar aims and objects.

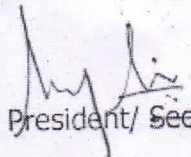
